Clinical and/or Medical Biochemists (two positions)

The Department of Pathology and Laboratory Medicine of The Ottawa Hospital (TOH) invites applications for **two** permanent full-time biochemist positions.

TOH is a 1,200 bed, three campus tertiary care teaching hospital affiliated with the University of Ottawa. TOH is a member of the Eastern Ontario Regional Laboratory Association (EORLA), which is the Champlain Local Health Integration Network's (LHIN) regional laboratory system.

As part of an energetic team of five biochemists, the successful candidates will join a very busy division which processes approximately five million tests per year, providing a broad spectrum of biochemistry services to TOH, The University of Ottawa Heart Institute and other health care providers in the Champlain LHIN. The candidates will supervise analytical, technical and clinical services within the biochemistry laboratory, and will provide regional clinical biochemistry support to other members of the EORLA. Administrative activities will include participation in divisional, departmental, hospital and regional committees and participation in strategic planning. The successful candidates are also expected to engage in academic activities including: undergraduate and postgraduate teaching, continuing education activities and/or independent or collaborative research in basic or clinical science or applied biochemistry. Outstanding opportunities for collaborative research exist through interactions with the Ottawa Hospital Research Institute (OHRI) and the University of Ottawa research network.

The ideal candidates will have excellent interpersonal skills and ability to communicate effectively, in order to interact with a diverse range of internal and external individuals and teams including: laboratory, technical, administrative, medical and scientific staff, clinicians, nurses and other health care providers as well as other non-clinical staff.

The successful candidates must have (or be eligible for) certification or Fellowship with the Canadian Academy of Clinical Biochemists (or equivalent) or the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons. Salary and academic rank will be commensurate with experience and qualifications.

Ottawa and the National Capital Region are thriving multicultural and bilingual environments which offer a variety of arts, cultural and sports activities.

The Ottawa Hospital encourages applications from qualified women and men, including persons with disabilities, members of visible minorities and aboriginal people.
